We empty our cup, stop listening to our own endless chatter, and then bear witness, looking at beings and relationships all around us and ask: What is it like to be you?

When we take ourselves out of the equation, presence emerges, and out of presence, spontaneous loving action.

Most important, we become a bridge, thus reflecting the One Body, the One Family, that we all are.
